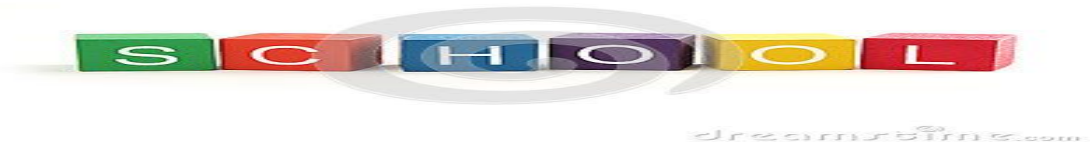


CAROLINE EDUCATION COMMUNITY INTERNATIONAL PSA



“SCHOOL OF EXCELLENCE”

Caroline Education Community International Public School Academy (“CECI PSA”) a Pre-K - 12 “School of excellence” initiation is sponsored by the St. Augustine’s National Foundation.

The CAROLINE EDUCATION COMMUNITY INTERNATIONAL PSA; “Our Lady Ana-Carolina School of Excellence” (“CECI PSA” | “Public School Academy” | “PSA”) provides rigorous competition within the public school district to stimulate continual improvement in all public schools.

The School seeks to provide rigorous competition within the local district through the creation of a top-notch arts infused school with an emphasis on painting and drawing. The driving force of the School is its emphasis on infusing artistic excellence and high standards for all into the daily curriculum.

Through a rigorous academic curriculum and a highly qualified staff in the arts (teacher development/training), the school provides a model for education throughout the local district.

Thus, based on the principle that infusing artistic excellence into the school is of paramount importance to a well-rounded education, the school not only provides a rigorous academic curriculum, but also teachers driven to inspire a superior level of artistic expression and a model for the district that will stimulate and motivate ongoing improvement for all other public schools.

The CECI PSA; Our Lady Ana-Carolina School of Excellence (“Public School Academy” | “CECI PSA”) is designed to provide a learning environment that is conducive to the development of individual human potential, and quality education that promotes high self-esteem and academic success for all students through small, multi-age classes.

The school’s structure is designed to create problem solvers, critical thinkers, and self-directness that will help the students make the transition into the upper grades, and later into society.

Currently, Caroline Education Community International PSA (“CECI”) offers classes from pre-kindergarten through eighth grade serving 681 students and their families. As well, grades 9 - 12 serving 321 students and their families. Ninety percent of the student body is Black American, improvised, and deemed economically disenfranchised, and over 85 percent of the students receive subsidized lunches.

CECI PSA chose to target the Cities of Promise throughout the state of Michigan specifically Inkster precisely because it was one of the most underserved communities in metro Detroit. As well, Flint, wherein the cognitive capacity of school age children has been impacted as a result of challenges due to lead-poisoning of the Flint water supply.

Essentially, the campus for the CECI PSA primary schools are located in Michigan cities including Inkster, Detroit, Pontiac, and Flint in facilities that have been restored to house CECI PSA.

As CECI PSA is a center for community and family life, the CECI Intermediate School District ("CECI * ISD") is located within the main campus of the Detroit school facility, and serves for use of administrative purposes including food distribution, and homeland security.
